Marriage at St Clements Notting Dale & St James Norlands

Notes

1. If you do not live within the Parish, you will need to prove that you have another **qualifying connection** to the Church, which in turn has to be agreed to by the Vicar. Please see the Church of England website (http://www.churchofengland.org/) for further details.

You can marry at St Clements or St James if one of you:

- has, at any time, lived in the parish for **six** months or more.
- > was baptised in the parish or:
- > was prepared for confirmation in the parish
- has at any time regularly gone to normal church services in the parish church for a period of at least **six** months

Or if one of your parents:

- has lived in the parish for at least **six** months, at any time **after** you were born, or:
- has regularly gone to normal church services in the parish church for at least **six** months Or if one of your parents or grandparents:
- was married in the parish
- 2. When returning this form, please bring the following original identity documents to the Parish Office:
 - a. Your British passport, or a birth certificate, or an overseas passport with a visa
 - b. A valid letter, dated within the last three months, which shows both your name and address, such as a utility bill or bank statement.
 - We will photocopy these and return them immediately.
- 3. Please note that the date you request can only be offered provisionally, and will be passed onto and finalised by the Vicar, who can discuss further arrangements with you and arrange a meeting in person.
- 4. If you do live within the Parish, but you are getting married elsewhere, you will require your Wedding Banns to be read. This means that for three consecutive weeks before the wedding your intention to get married has to be announced during each Sunday Service. If you require Banns only, please make sure you indicate this clearly on the form.
- 5. You are not obliged to attend the reading of your Wedding Banns but please make a note if you would like to attend any of the services where your banns will be read, and we will notify you of the dates once they are formalised with the Vicar.
- 6. A full list of wedding fees is available upon request from the Parish Office.
- 7. You may use the Gardens attached to both churches after your marriage service. Please keep the time you use them to under 45 minutes. St James's Gardens are owned by a separate organisation and so we ask you to stay to the immediate vicinity of the Church.
- 8. Confetti may be used **only** if it is biodegradable.
